

### Coming from Denver International Airport and all points east of Denver

1. Take Pena Boulevard out of the airport. [10 miles]
2. Follow signs and merge onto I-70 West. [10 miles]
3. Take the Brighton Boulevard ramp (exit 275b). At the bottom of the ramp, turn left onto Brighton Boulevard. Brighton Boulevard will eventually curve to the left and become Broadway. Stay on Broadway. [9 miles]
4. Turn right on Blake Street (one-way). Note Coors Field on your right. [0.7 miles]
5. Turn left on 17<sup>th</sup> Street (one-way). [0.5 miles]
6. Turn left on Curtis Street (one-way). [0.1 miles]

### Coming from Colorado Springs and all points south of Denver

1. On I-25 going north.
2. Take the Auraria Parkway ramp (exit 210c). The off-ramp will curve to the right and become Auraria Parkway (note the Pepsi Center on your left). It will become Market Street as you cross Speer Boulevard. Stay on Market Street. [2 miles]
3. Turn right on 17<sup>th</sup> Street (one-way). [0.4 miles]
4. Turn left on Curtis Street (one-way). [0.1 miles]

### Coming from Fort Collins and all points north of Denver

1. On I-25 going south.
2. Take the 20<sup>th</sup> Street ramp (exit 212c). At the end of the ramp, turn left onto 20<sup>th</sup> Street. Note Coors Field on your left. [2 miles]
3. Turn right on Blake Street (one-way). [0.3 miles]
4. Turn left on 17<sup>th</sup> Street (one-way). [0.5 miles]
5. Turn left on Curtis Street (one-way). [0.1 miles]

### Coming from Vail and all points west of Denver

1. On I-70 going east.
2. Follow the signs and merge onto I-25 South. [0.9 miles]
3. Take the 20<sup>th</sup> Street ramp (exit 212c). At the end of the ramp, turn left onto 20<sup>th</sup> Street. Note Coors Field on your left. [2 miles]
4. Turn right on Blake Street (one-way). [0.3 miles]
5. Turn left on 17<sup>th</sup> Street (one-way). [0.5 miles]
6. Turn left on Curtis Street (one-way). [0.1 miles]

ASTECH's office is located in the South Tower of the Denver Place complex. It is the silver and black building on the corner of 18<sup>th</sup> and Curtis streets, and it will be on your right as you come down Curtis Street. We recommend you park in the public lot on Curtis Street – it will be on your right just before you hit 18<sup>th</sup> Street. If you're lucky, you'll find an open meter, but the meters are good for only two hours.
